Water for Scotland – Application for assessment as a Self-Lay Organisation

Thank you for your recent application for assessment as a Self-Lay Organisation.

Following your attendance at the DOMS workshop on the 21st December 2006 I would confirm your obligations with regard to cascading training materials within your organisation.

Firstly, all relevant DOMS toolbox talks are to be embedded into your organisation by the end of January 2007 also training records must be forwarded to Scottish Water.

Secondly, all operatives undertaking controlled activities on potable water mains must be in possession of a valid National Hygiene ID card managed by the Energy & Utilities Company by the end of March 2007.

I have reviewed your application and can confirm that your organisation meets our assessment criteria within Water for Scotland. Consequently, your organisation is now accredited to carry out future contestable work (i.e. water main laying / service connections).
